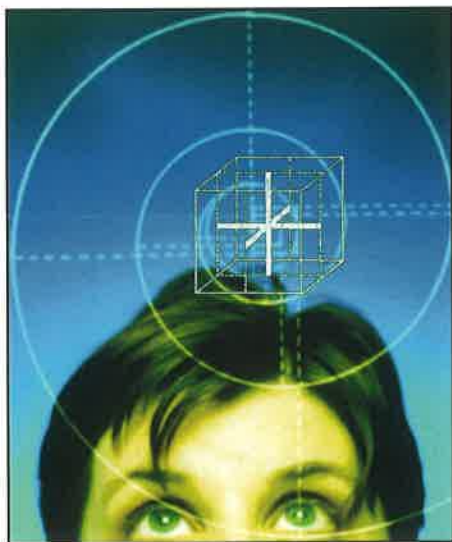

STIPENDS

Stipends (9month) are adjusted continuously to reflect increases in living expenses and currently range between \$13,473 and \$14,562 (in some cases, that amount may be increased by a supplemental award or grant funding) plus tuition grant for the academic year (9 months), depending on the source of support. Additional summer support is usually available.



SPECIAL PROGRAMS AND CENTERS

The Department of Psychology contains the Psychology Clinic, the Autism Spectrum Disorders Clinic, the Geropsychology Clinic, and the Disruptive Behavior Disorders Clinic through which clinical graduate students receive primary instruction and training. Other programs include the Alabama Attention-Deficit/Hyperactive Disorder (ADHD) and Anxiety program, the Center for the Prevention of Youth Behavior Problems, and the Alabama Research Institute on Aging.
